A £50 deposit per ride is required once your booking has been accepted - to be paid online on our website.

In the first instance, use our Preliminary Common Ridings Booking Request (Form 1) to advise which ride(s) and horese(s) you would like. We will check if we have horses available and suitable for you, then we will confirm the booking. Once confirmed, you pay your deposit online using, Common Ridings Confirmed Booking Deposit Form(2). The terms of us accepting the booking are subject to you, riding at least 4 times prior to your ride (with us) or submitting RECENT video evidence of riding, within last 2 months.

You will receive an automated receipt

Once a Deposit has been paid and your horse booked, we will endeavour to keep you with that horse, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Deposits are non refundable under any circumstances.

Whilst we take every care to provide you with a suitable mount in accordance with your request and stated riding experience, we accept no responsibility for any accident or injury incurred, howsoever occasioned.

In the interests of safety we insist that all riders come and try out their mount prior to their rideout. This must be done as near to your booking as possible. Please do not leave this too late as horses get booked up fast. Please note, any rider that swaps their horse whilst on the ride, without our permission, will invalidate our insurance.

No hats are provided by us unless by prior arrangement. All hats must conform to current standard PAS015 (1998 & 2011) with Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark.

VG1 with Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark. ASTM F1163 2004a onwards with SEI Mark. SNELL E2001 or E2016.AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. – if in doubt please check with us. Please note, our insurance will not cover berets, bowlers etc.

Due to the costs involved in preparing and transporting a horse to a ride, if a deposit has not been paid, no horse will be taken to the ride for you.
